CURRICULUM



Science:

Our children learn key content and principles of science as they engage in hands-on activities.

Mathematics:

Through exposure to various kinds of play, children develop math skills in areas such as measurement, graphing, adding and subtracting.

Language and Literacy:

We support early literacy skills by introducing Houghton Mifflin reading materials.

Music/Movement:

With our music teacher, children use memory skills and auditory discrimination, while learning the principles of music.

Creative Development:

We provide opportunities and materials which may at times be “messy”, but believe “paint and mud wash off, creativity sticks.”

Personal and Social Competencies:

We support children’s social and emotional development for Kindergarten readiness.

Gross Motor Development:

Children engage in activities that help them develop their large muscles and gain proficiency in motor skills.

Fine Motor Development:

We introduce many of the materials from the “Handwriting Without Tears” curriculum to support pre-printing and printing in a fun, stress-free atmosphere.

Children’s Garden:

Our gardening program introduces children to many life-long values such as perseverance, patience, and respect while connecting children with the earth and allowing them to observe nature first hand.
